Reported that the 2015 State Scenic Byways Report went to print last week and should be available for distribution in August. The FDOT also approved a budget for promotional items and gave us a few bubble pens for our next booth appearance. Also mentioned that the state is rewriting the FSHP manual and a workplan request will come out in 2016 for the year. The byways throughout Florida is discussing the possibility of forming a statewide Byway Advocacy Group to create awareness statewide.
