

Scenic Sumter Heritage Byway Corridor Management Entity (CME)

Minutes from October 16, 2013 meeting Dade Battlefield State Park 7200 CR 603, Bushnell, FL

- I. Call to Order and introduction of guests: Meeting was called to order by Dan McCormic (Explore Sumter County). Others in attendance included, Paul Remis (City of Webster, Dade Battlefield SP, Sumter Historic Society), Bruce Root (SCPW), Dawn Cary (Sumter County Chamber of Commerce), Bob Finck (Atkins N.A.), Mike Palozzi (CB&I), Steve Rinck (Dade Battlefield Society), Donna Lester (UF/IFAS Extension), Joyce Hanson (VFW Post #10137), Garry Balogh (FDOT) and Gayle Teerman (SCORE and Native Americans).
- **II. Review of September 18, 2013 Minutes** Joyce Hanson made a motion to approve with the changes suggested. Paul Remis seconded.

III. Non-Profit Corporation status

A. Application Package- Packet was mailed to the IRS on October 16, 2013.

IV. Chamber of Commerce Luncheon Presentation-Oct. 9th

- **A. Post Luncheon Report:** We collected approximately \$3700.00 in sponsorships the day of the luncheon.
- **B. Follow up:** Will be sending out a tax deductible letter with a decal. Mike will send the draft to Dawn. Discussion on the decal and pricing. Joyce brought up discussion of the game plan of visiting the businesses on the byway to inform them of the Designation Celebration and Sponsorship opportunities.
